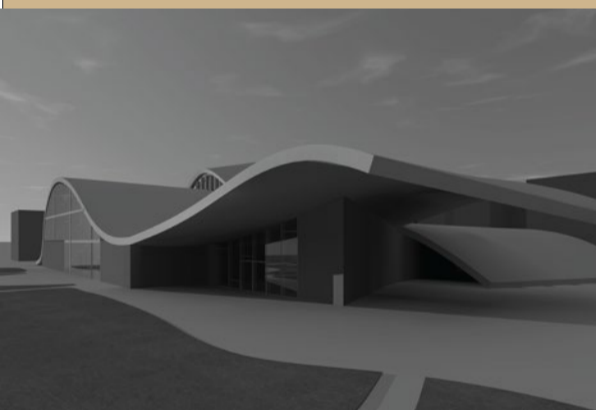

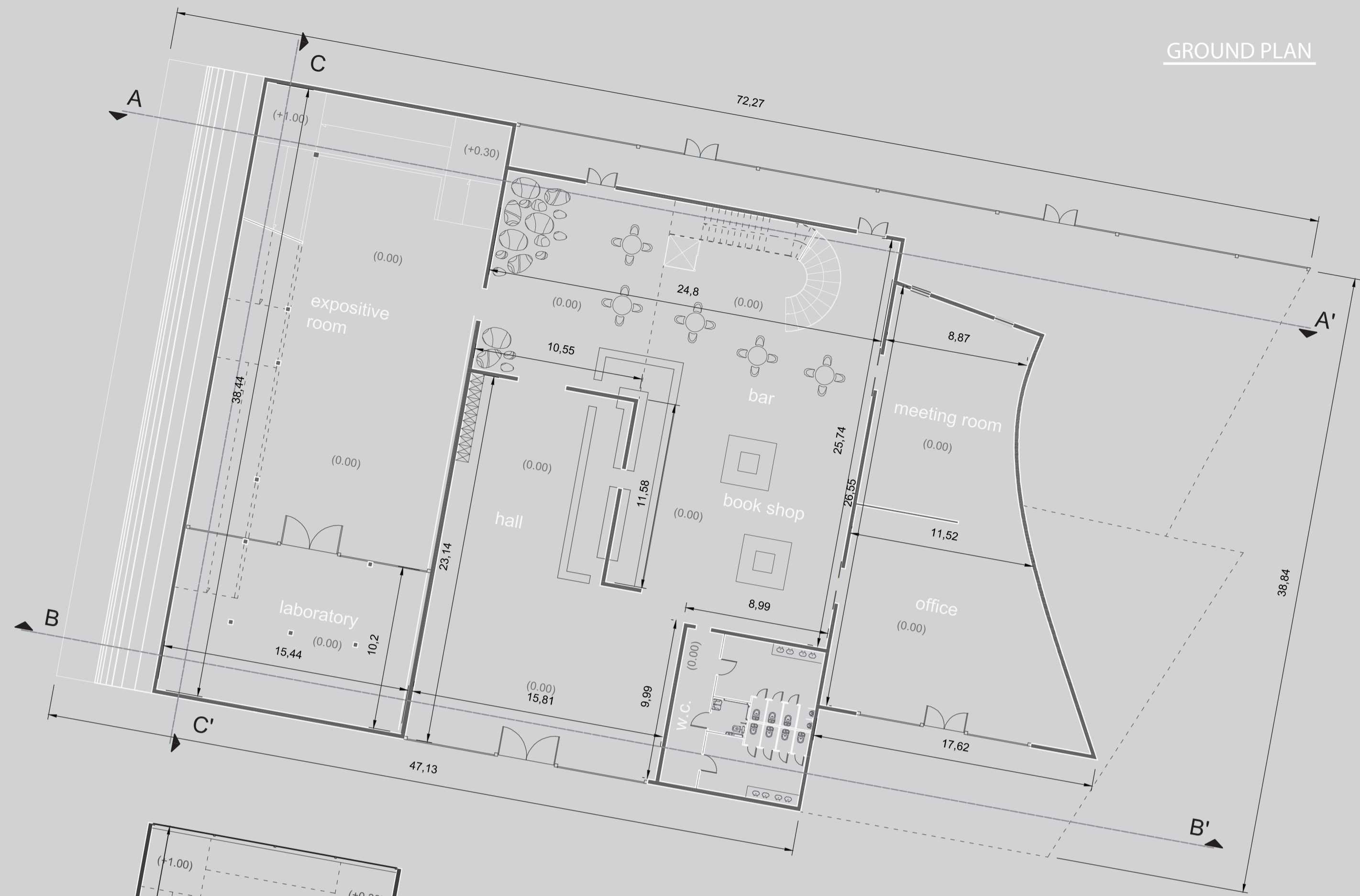

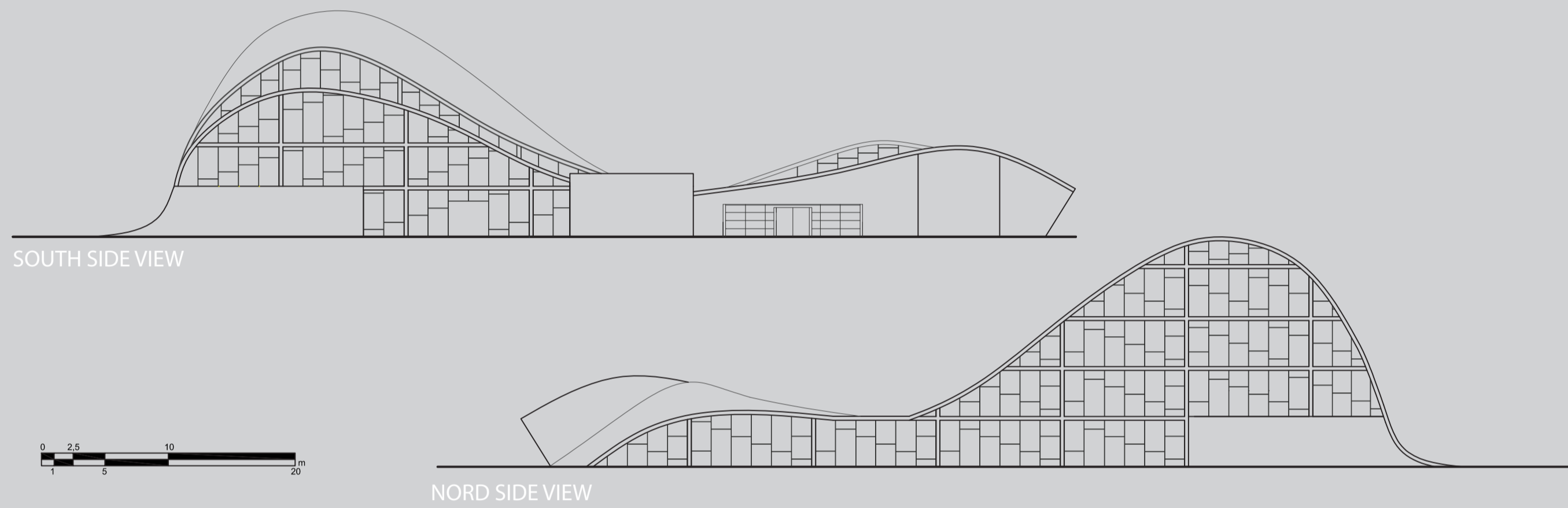

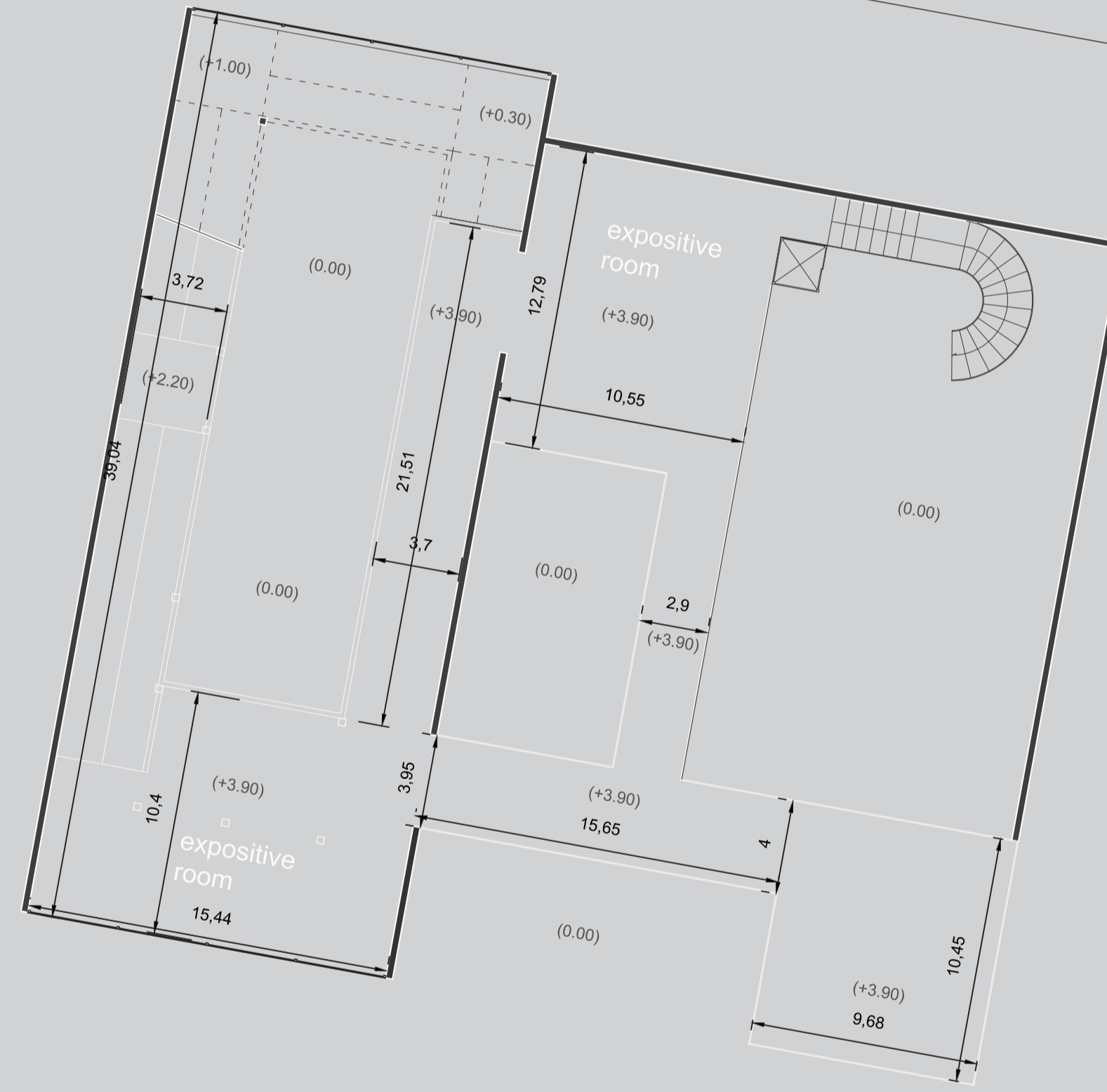


GROUND PLAN

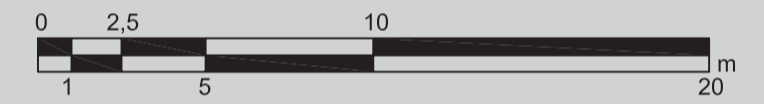


SOUTH SIDE VIEW

Historical References

The city of Canakkale lies on the narrowest point of the Dardanelles which connects the Sea of Marmara with the Aegean Sea and, like Istanbul, has a European side and an Asian side.

It is the closest town to the historic site of Troy, the wooden horse of the 2004 movie "Troy" with Brad Pitt has appeared on the waterfront.

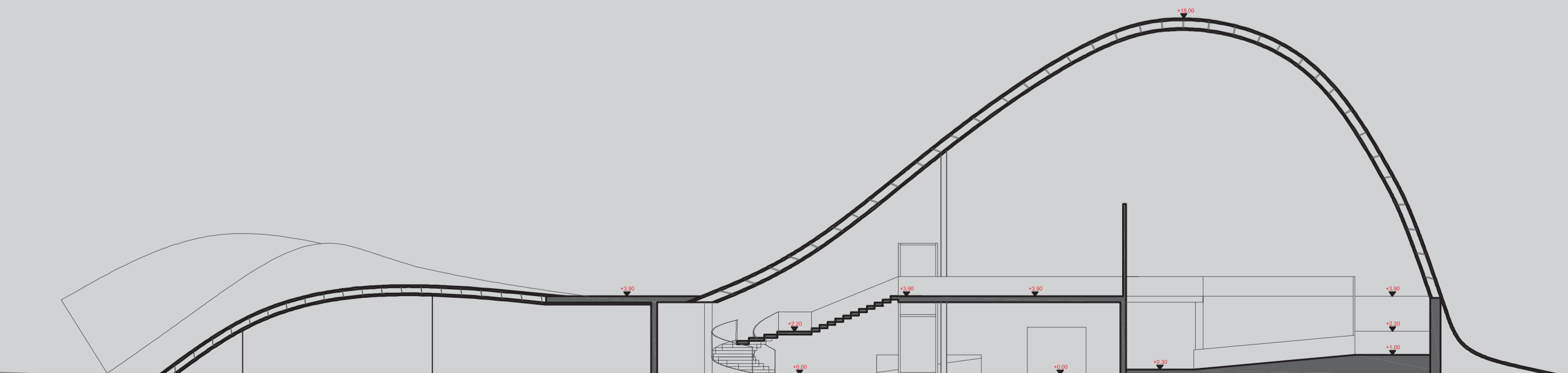
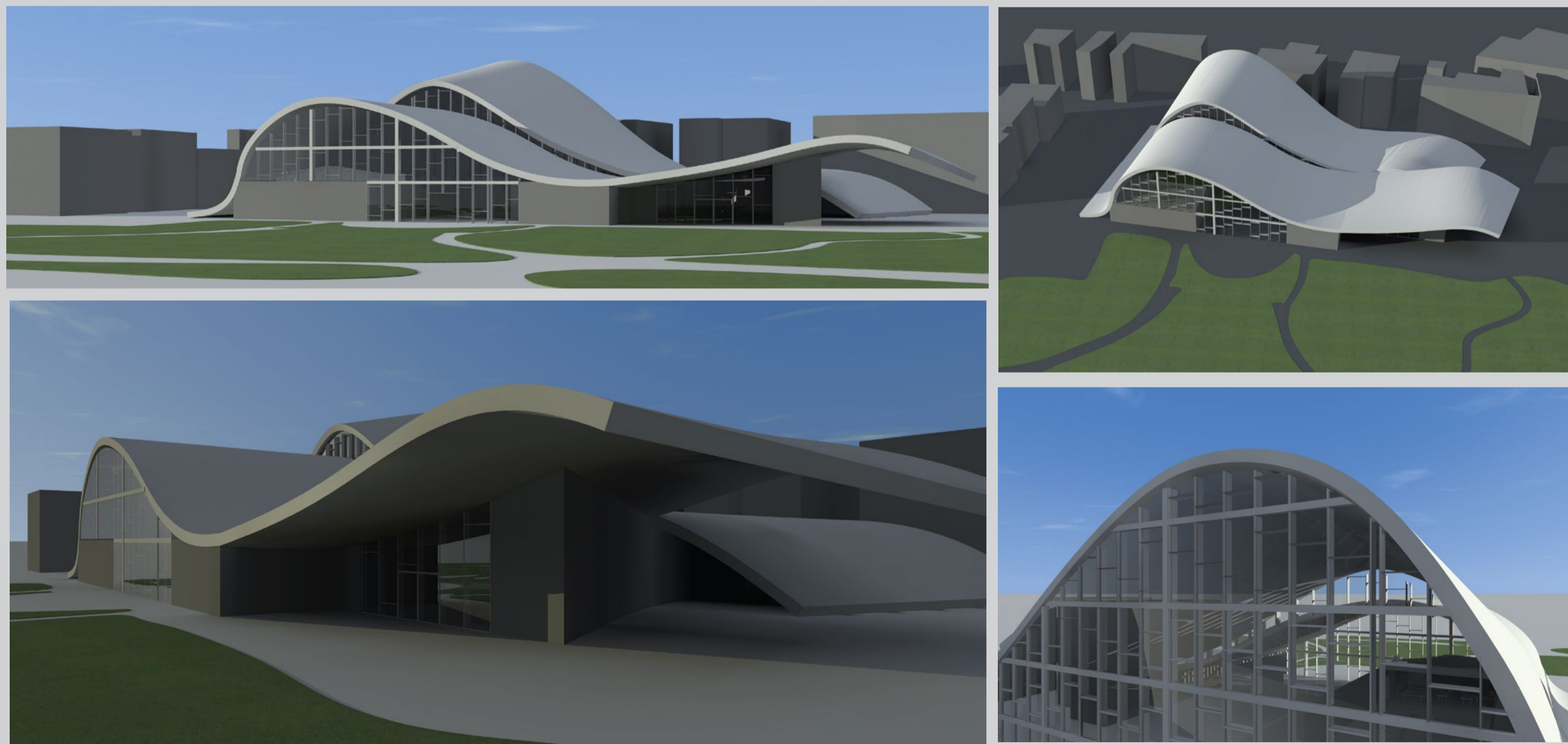
The Byzantines called it "Dardanellia" from which is derived the name of the strait; during the Ottoman Sultan Mehmet II built here two fortresses, one on the Asian side and another on the European side and in fact the city was called "Sultaniye Kalesi" Fortress of the Sultan. Later the city became famous for its pottery from whose term Turkish took its current name (Canak Kalesi or the fortress of ceramic).

The real story begins with Troy Canakkale which was built around 3500-3000 BC. Ionic After, the region came under the control of the strands and later the Persians before being conquered by Alexander the Great in the famous battle of the Granicus River. During the Roman period, the city became an important trading port. Soon it was subject to repeated attacks of the Arabs first and then the Ottoman Turks who conquered it in the fourteenth century..

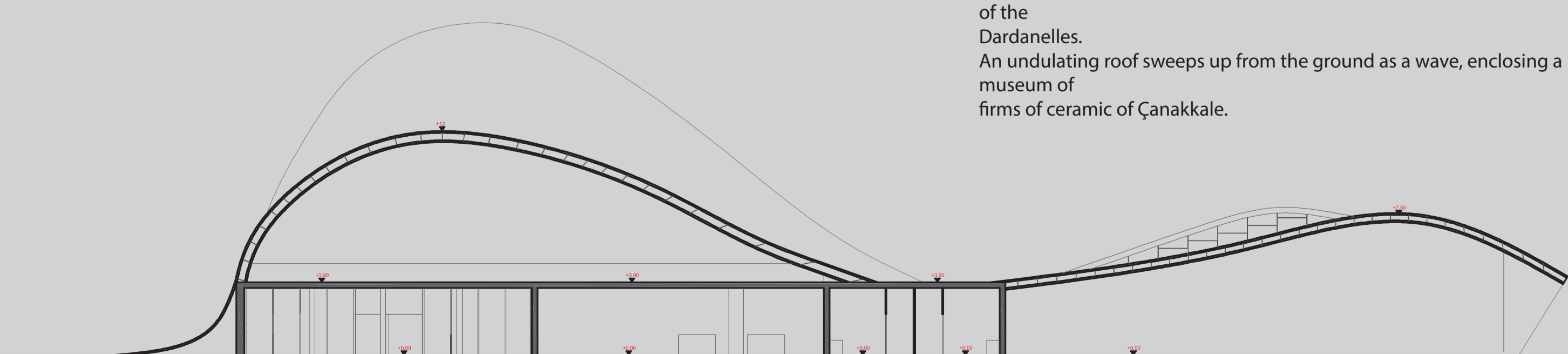
Concept

A concept inspired by the fluid geometry of water in motion, creating spaces and a surrounding environment in sympathy with the river landscape of the Dardanelles.

An undulating roof sweeps up from the ground as a wave, enclosing a museum of firms of ceramic of Canakkale.
